

# KC COMMUNITY COVENANT

King's Commission is a ministry dedicated to the highest standards of excellence in personal development and spiritual growth. Scripture teaches us to, "set our minds on things above, not on earthly things." Col. 3:2 Hours of our time are poorly spent. God speaks to us through the apostle Paul and gives us these words, "Be very careful, then, how you live - not as unwise but as wise, making the most of every opportunity for the days are evil." Eph. 5:15-16 As a community we will learn how we can make the most of each day He has given and utilizing each talent that He has placed within us.

King's Commission is designed to be an intense training ground for life. For this reason we as a community will take this covenant to remove all distractions, and focus intently on Christ.

We as individuals agree to living according to these standards.

**Dating** No Dating. This is to free students to pursue Christ.

It is understood that within the time period of 9 months a student may feel attraction towards a fellow student. Galatians 5 speaks about the fruit of the Spirit called, self-control. We believe that this ministry was born out of a calling of the Holy Spirit for this specific time. If God has ordained this ministry and placed His anointing upon it, He will not violate the standards that are set in place.

We believe that God will raise up students/young adults with enough Godly character to remove themselves from the program if they willingly let a thought form an emotional and mental attraction to another student.

**TV** No TV. This applies to students while on the conference grounds.

We do not expect a student to confront a host home in reference to this standard. But we do expect that a student always respect God's standard, finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable - if anything is excellent or praiseworthy - think about such things. Phil. 4:8

If a host home is watching something that violates this standard, a student should tactfully, nonchalantly excuse themselves.

**Dress** We expect modest dress from all participants.

Modesty is a key component to the success of King's Commission. How one dresses either attracts or detracts from conveying a message pointing to Christ, or a message pointing to us. No apparel accentuating any curves or accentuating any skin above hands width of the knees and below the neckline will be permitted, either on campus or during times of ministry.

Scripture condemns such attitudes as greed, jealousy, pride, lust, needless anger, an unforgiving spirit, harmful discrimination, and prejudice. Furthermore, certain behaviors are expressively prohibited by Scripture. These include theft, lying, cheating, plagiarism, gossip, slander, profanity, vulgarity, adultery, homosexual behavior, premarital or extramarital sex, sexual promiscuity, soft and hard pornography, drunkenness, gluttony, immodesty and occult practices. (Galatians 5:19-21, 1 Corinthians 6:9-10).

Since the body of the Christian is the temple of the Holy Spirit, it deserves respect and preservation of its well-being. Therefore, the use of alcohol, illegal drugs, tobacco in any form, and the abuse of prescriptions and over-the-counter drugs violates our community standard.

I have read and understand that I am to be governed by these principles and expectations. Failure to comply with these standards will result in discipline by the ministry program.
